
IN RE: Re-Appointment of Board of Zoning Commission Member Joan S. Gallagher



Dear Trustees:

Please consider my reappointment to the Board of Zoning Commission when my term expires at the end of March. Since my tenure began in June of 1998, I have supported the Residential-Planned Overlay District (R-POD) as well as the Sugarcreek Township Comprehensive Land Use Plan.

In the summer of 2002, the Zoning Commission voted to maintain the 5-acre minimum in the southern part of the township. The Commission was responsive to the residents and their opinions at several public hearings regarding this issue.

In the fall of 2008, Sugarcreek, in alliance with the City of Bellbrook, placed a Merger Study Issue on the General Election ballot to thwart further attempts of annexation by the City of Centerville. This issue passed. I had the privilege to serve as Merger Committee Co-chair for Sugarcreek Township through the process of investigating the logistics of a possible merger. Although a merger of the two entities was eventually not deemed financially feasible, the interaction was well worth the effort to foster communication and co-operation between Sugarcreek Township and Bellbrook.

Though all these endeavors, I feel that I have been instrumental in encouraging a responsible vote for the "General Welfare" of Sugarcreek Township. Thus, I would like to continue to serve the Sugarcreek residents as a member of the Board of Zoning Commission.
