WHEREAS, Mr. Miller has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since August 15, 2011, and,


WHEREAS, Mr. Corwin has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since May 7, 2012, and,




CHIEF'S,
