WHEREAS, Firefighter John M. Long submitted his letter of resignation on August 15, 2013, from the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department; and,


WHEREAS, Mr. Long has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since June 16, 2009, and,

WHEREAS, Chief Randall J. Pavlak recommends that we accept the resignation of John M. Long,




