IN RE: Proclaiming National Work Zone Awareness Week


WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has declared April 7 – 11, 2014, as National Work Zone Awareness Week; and,

WHEREAS, National Work Zone Awareness Week is an annual event aimed at bringing national attention to motorist and worker safety and mobility issues in work zones; and,


WHEREAS, each year most work zone fatalities – approximately 85-90% - are motorists and their occupants, and 10-15% of fatalities are workers and other non-motorized users such as pedestrians and bicyclists; and,

WHEREAS, National Work Zone Awareness Week began in 1999 when the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA), and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) signed a Memorandum of Agreement pledging to increase public awareness of work zone safety issues through a national media campaign; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Sugarcreek Township Board of Trustees hereby proclaims the Week of April 7 – 11, 2014, as National Work Zone Awareness Week.
