



Administrator's Report to the Trustees
August 18, 2014

The following represents a brief update of the activities, information and issues which the Administration is currently working on:

- Salt for the roads this winter has become the topic of much discussion over the past two weeks. As part of SWOP4G, we use the collaborative buying power of 101 agencies in primarily southwest Ohio to receive the best pricing on salt each year. Of the 101 agencies who requested bids this year, only a total of 12 will receive salt due to availability. This is affecting the entire Midwest and the surrounding states to Ohio.

Of the 12 entities receiving bids, eight (8) are in Greene County. (Sugar Creek Township, Beavercreek City, Bellbrook and Xenia City.) The other four (4) include Kettering, Centerville, Clearcreek Township and the City of Mason. These eight will receive a total of 28,500 tons of salt from Cargill. An additional 25,000 tons will be received from North American Salt Co. and will be split to Middletown, Montgomery County, and two other agencies to the north.

The 101 agencies requested a total of 255,000 tons of salt collectively, and as of today, we will only be receiving 53,500 to be shared by all of us. This will require a great amount of logistical work on the part of all agencies.

We currently have about 550 tons of salt on hand. On average, we use about 1,200 tons each year. Our bin holds about 1,300 tons without over packing it. Our goal will be to fill the bin and share the excess amount from our bid. Mr. Geyer hosted a meeting of all of the Greene County agencies this morning and we agreed that standards for application of salt and plowing need to be established and practiced by all agencies.

- Attended the Greene County Commissioners meeting on August 7th regarding the RPCC. The meeting was very well attended by the Townships in the county and there was good discussion and a plan to meet within four weeks at a public meeting with the Commissioners to work through the detailed operations of the RPCC and establish a good description of what work should be done by the agency and how to operate more efficiently within their budget. The Commissioners agreed to establish the date for the workshop and notify the attending agencies. To date we have not received any information on when that meeting will be.

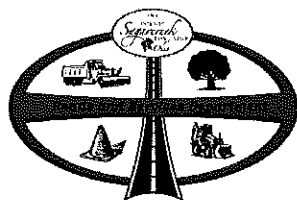
