
IN RE: Declaration of Excess Police Department Property

WHEREAS, the Sugarcreek Township Police Department has identified equipment which is no longer needed for operations, and;


WHEREAS, Chief Michael Brown is requesting the attached list of items be declared as excess property and sold "as is"; and,

WHEREAS, the items listed have an individual value of \$2,000 or less,



I recommend that we dispose of a large aluminum equipment storage box that we have had in storage for quite some time. This storage box was originally installed in a 1999 Chevrolet Suburban which is no longer in the fleet. It will not fit any vehicle we have at this time and because of its size will not fit any modern down sized police vehicles produced at this time or anticipated in the future.
