



**Administrator's Report to the Trustees
December 15, 2014**

The following represents a brief update of the activities, information and issues which the Administration is currently working on:

- A great deal of time has been spent with the OTA and CLOUT in recent days to have a positive impact on the "lame duck" items in the General Assembly before year end. We have seen some good outcomes, but the Senate was not responsive to what we consider to be a very important item in HB 277. The senate committee did not take any action on the bill this week and has decided to take it up next year. The bill will need to be re-introduced, but that may be best given that Senator Seitz presented three amendments to the bill at the last moment leading to non-action. We oppose all three amendments as presented, but are willing to seek compromise on one of the amendments. The other two must be removed.

We will wait to see if the governor signs other positive bills including additional revenue from the state to townships. The bill, if passed would appropriate an additional \$10M for townships next year in the local government fund. The first \$5M would be distributed evenly by all townships, with each receiving approximately \$3,800. The second \$5M would be distributed by road mile to each township. We would receive approximately \$6,000 from that pool for a total of almost \$10k.

- Our benefits cooperative continues to push forward for a self-funded plan in 2015. Recent meetings included presentations by several companies who would oversee the plan for us. Again, the anticipated savings is at least 5% the first year.
- The response from our citizens regarding the formation of the Fire District continues to be very positive.

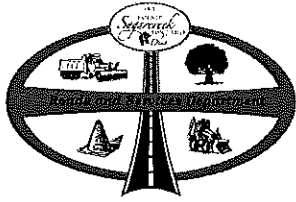
