IN RE: Declaration of Excess Fire Department Property


WHEREAS, the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department has identified equipment which is no longer needed for operations, and;


WHEREAS, Chief Randall Pavlak is requesting the attached list of items be declared as excess property and sold "as is"; and,
