
IN RE: Declaration of Excess Road Department Property

WHEREAS, the Sugarcreek Township Road Department has identified equipment which is no longer needed for operations, and;


WHEREAS, Anthony Lamb, Service Supervisor, is requesting the attached list of items be declared as excess property and sold "as is"; and,
