WHEREAS, this cooperative Collective Bid Program affords significant savings to Sugarcreek Township through the economies of scale realized by group purchasing and unified contract administration,



**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GREENE COUNTY ENGINEER
AND
THE SUGARCREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

The Greene County Engineer and the Sugarcreek Township Board of Trustees (hereinafter referred to as the Engineer and the Trustees, respectively), agree to the following:

WHEREAS, the Trustees desire to participate with the Engineer in the competitive bid contract for the **Center Line/Edge Line (County doing work) for 2015** as bid by the Greene County Engineer.

WHEREAS, all work within the Trustees' jurisdiction, shall be inspected by and all questions decided which may arise as to quality and acceptability of materials furnished, work performed, the rate of progress; the interpretation of the specifications, by the Trustees and the acceptable fulfillment of the contract on the part of the Contractor.

WHEREAS, the Contractor will invoice the Trustees directly for the actual quantities of work performed, all line item extras, and/or negotiated extra work in accordance with ORC 5575.05.
