IN RE: Recognizing National Public Works Week


WHEREAS, Citizens are served every day by public servants at the federal, state, county, city and township levels, who supply continuity to our democratic society; and,

WHEREAS, public employees make great contributions to the communities they serve and are committed to exhibiting the highest standards of excellence, dedication and skills; and,




