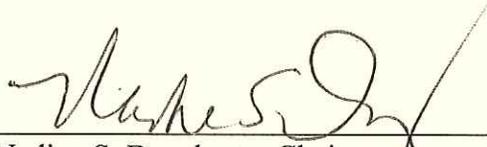
**IN RE:** Resignation of Part-time Firefighter/Paramedic Benjamin Berg

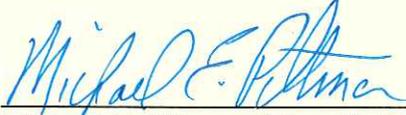
WHEREAS, Firefighter/Paramedic Benjamin Berg has submitted his letter of resignation from the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department; and,

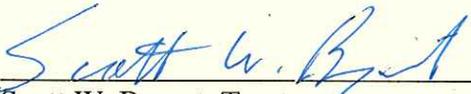
WHEREAS, Mr. Berg has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since April 16, 2007; and,
