



Administrator's Report to the Trustees
August 17, 2015

The following represents a brief update of the activities, information and issues which the Administration is currently working on:

- Attended the Home Builders Association Developer's Forum at Greene County Sanitary Engineering. Development appears to be picking up countywide and in the region. Sugar Creek appears to have the highest interest in single family residential currently.
- Attended the quarterly Economic Development Retention and Expansion meeting at Clark State.
- Working with the OTA and CLOUT Legislative Committees to construct new law language on annexation and economic development incentives for townships. With the loss of JEDDZ's, redevelopment is more challenging than ever for townships. It will be difficult to convince the legislature to give us the JEDDZ back, so we must be creative and try to construct a new mechanism that essentially does the same thing.
- We are continuing to work on the grant for Centerpointe Drive extension.
- Clio Road construction has had some challenges in the past two weeks regarding engineering issues and items in the field. I have met with Bob Geyer and members of his office along with the contractor to try to get things resolved. We have a couple of outstanding issues that we are working through.

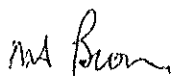

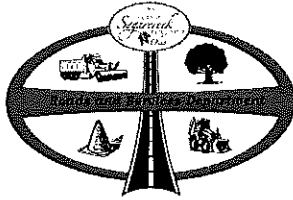
