- The lawsuit filed by Cornerstone in the Federal Court has been dismissed. Portions of the suit cannot be brought again as a result of the judge's ruling. Cornerstone was given 30 days to amend the balance of the suit, if desired.
- Cornerstone filed a new suit in Green County Courts on Tuesday the 10th. The majority of the suit is identical to the previous submission filed in the courts earlier in the year.
- All response I have heard from the residents and businesses in the Township and outside of the Township is in positive regarding the formation of the Fire District.
- Attended the Ministerial Association meeting on the 12th to update them on issues in the Township. The meeting was well attended and they appreciate everything the Board of Trustees is doing to preserve the Township.
- Attended the Montgomery County Township Association meeting on November 12th to discuss pending legislation and CLOUT issues in the state.

The Board of Trustees of Sugarcreek Township, Greene County, Ohio, met in Regular Session on October 19, 2015 at 7:00 pm, at 2090 Ferry Road, Bellbrook, Ohio 45305.

1. Mr. Pittman called the session to order at 7:00 pm.
2. Mr. Hodson called the roll with Board Members Mike Pittman, Scott Bryant, and Mrs. Daugherty being present. In addition to Mr. Tiffany, Township Administrator, others who signed in, were Jim Martin, Rick Parsons, Kristen Parsons, Donna Hellman, Melissa McKeever, Shanna Staten, Denise Moore, Jim Hogue, Barbara Burson, and Carolyn Destefani.
3. All rose and recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
4. Promotion of Full-Time Police Sergeant Gabriel Plummer.

Resolution No. 2015.10.19.01

WHEREAS, Officer Gabriel Plummer was appointed a full time police officer with Sugarcreek Township on December 18, 2006; and,

WHEREAS, Officer Gabriel Plummer has shown himself to be a dedicated employee; and,

WHEREAS, Officer Gabriel Plummer meets all the requirements for this promotion and accepts full responsibility for the position;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that full time Police Officer Gabriel Plummer shall be promoted to full time Police Sergeant for the Police Department effective October 19, 2015, at a rate of \$30.05 per hour, payable on a bi-weekly basis, and subject to a one (1) year probationary period ending October 20, 2016.

Mrs. Daugherty moved to accept the Resolution as presented. Mr. Pittman seconded. Roll was called with the vote being as follows:

Mr. Pittman said he has known Mr. Plummer for a long time. He said he first started with the Township as our Zoning Officer. Mr. Bryant stated that this was a well deserved promotion and felt Mr. Plummer would be a great asset to the Township. Chief Brown stated this was a great opportunity for Gabe. Chief Brown came forward as did Gabriel Plummer and Mr. Plummer's girl friend and he was pinned with his new badge. Pictures were taken.

5. Community Activities

Mrs. Daugherty stated that Beggar's Night for both the City of Bellbrook and Sugarcreek Township would be Saturday, October 31st. Mr. Bryant spoke about Halloween in the Park which was October 17th saying the weather was great and they had a lot of people come out to participate. Nadine thanked the three candidates present that judged the contests. Mrs. Daugherty asked when the Farmer's Market is ending. Cara stated the end of November.

6. Reports

A. Administration

Mr. Tiffany's report will be appended to the permanent record. Mr. Tiffany said he has started interviewing candidates for the Fire Chief Position. We are working on legislative issues at the State level. It's a very busy time.

B. Fiscal Office

Mr. Hodson said there was a Resolution on the agenda tonight for The Acceptance of Rates for the Budget Commission. He said this is standard procedure and is for accepting the levy rates and amounts established by the Budget Commission. Mr. Hodson said, due to the CAUV tax recoupment from the new ongoing developments, the Township will receive an additional eighty seven thousand dollars in tax revenue in 2016. Mr. Bryant complimented Mr. Hodson on the letter received from the State regarding the recent audit. Mr. Hodson said the post audit meeting was waived because there was nothing of consequence to discuss. Mr. Pittman and Mrs. Daugherty also complimented him on the audit.

C. Fire

The report prepared by the Fire Department will be appended to the permanent record. Assistant Fire Chief Zimmerman said she had nothing to add at this time

D. Police

The report prepared by the Police Department will be appended to the permanent record. Chief Brown said he had nothing to add at this time

E. Roads and Services

The report for Roads and Services will be appended to the permanent record. Mr. Tiffany spoke about the Salt Issue saying a sample was sent to the vendor for analysis, but they said the specs were fine. Mr. Tiffany said he disagrees with them and has asked for an analysis report. He said we have a buyer for the current supply. Mr. Bryant asked if we have enough. Mr. Tiffany said we have another salt supplier available should we need them, but we will use what is out there. He said most of the paving, other than Ferry Road South, is done. Ferry Road will be paved in one day or one pull which means they will do both lanes at one time. He said the road will be closed just one day. Mrs. Daugherty spent a lot of time riding around all of the roads with Tony Lamb and she said she learned a lot.

F. Zoning

The report prepared by Cara Tilford, Director of Planning and Zoning, will be appended to the permanent record. Cara said she had nothing to add at this time.

G. Information Technology

The report prepared by Chris Zappanti, Director of Information Technology, will be appended to the permanent record. Chris said he had nothing to add at this time. Mr. Zappanti did say that it appears my report is not in the meeting folders. He said he turned it in, but he will resubmit it. Mr. Tiffany stated that Chris would be changing up the internal servers but we should be able to get emails and function with few interruptions.

Recreation. He said that the Park District is in need of a levy on the ballot to maintain their current trail system throughout the Country. Mr. Pittman said he felt it was important to support Issue 18.

10. Discussion Agenda Items

A. Entering Into An Agreement with Choice One Engineering for Centerpoint Drive Extension

Resolution No. 2015.10.19.05

WHEREAS, the Sugarcreek Township Board of Trustees have solicited, through the Greene County Engineer's Office, for submissions of qualifications for the engineering and design of the Centerpoint Drive Extension; and,

WHEREAS, several proposals were provided pursuant to the solicitation, each of which have been independently evaluated by the Greene County Engineer's Office and the Township Administrator for completeness; and,

WHEREAS, Choice One Engineering achieved the highest score of the proposals submitted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Trustees for Sugarcreek Township does hereby authorize the Township Administrator to act as the signatory and enter into an agreement with Choice One Engineering for the provision of engineering and design of the Center Pointe Drive Extension road project, a copy of the agreement attached hereto.

Mrs. Daugherty moved to accept the Resolution as presented. Mr. Pittman seconded. Roll was called with the vote being as follows:

Mr. Tiffany said that Centerpointe Drive will be extended across the front of the Redwood Development between Walmart and the new development. He said it would extend to connect to Clyo Road just East of the Public Safety Building. He said Redwood would pay for the first few hundred feet and the Township would pay for the rest. Mr. Tiffany said this would open up about 60 acres of Commercially Zoned property. He said this request is for engineering and design, not construction. He said we have received a grant of Issue II money for 1.1 million dollars. He said this would help offset the tax burden of the citizens. Mr. Bryant said this is a good move forward for the Township. Mr. Tiffany said the apartments will generate about \$300,000.00 for the schools.

B. Creation of Sugarcreek Township Fire District

Resolution No. 2015.10.19.06

WHEREAS, the Sugarcreek Township Board of Trustees has determined it expedient and necessary to guard against the occurrence of fires and to protect the property and lives of the citizens against damages resulting from their occurrence; and,

WHEREAS, in order to adequately guard against the occurrence of fires and to protect the property and lives of the citizens against damages resulting from their occurrence, the Sugarcreek Township Board of Trustees have identified the unincorporated area of Sugarcreek Township for inclusion into a Fire District; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 505.37© allows for the creation of a fire district.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Sugarcreek Township Board of Trustees hereby establishes and creates the "Sugarcreek Township Fire District, " which Fire District shall consist of all of the unincorporated territory of Sugarcreek Township.

Mrs. Daugherty asked Mr. Tiffany to explain the Fire District. Mr. Tiffany said that the township has had some issues with a fire service settlement with the City of Centerville. Unfortunately the only agreement by the City would require the residents of Sugarcreek Township to subsidize the fire services. In addition Centerville has asked that we give up our T.I.F. tax dollars coming to the Township to pay for Clyo Road. This board has heard very loudly and clearly from the township residents to not settle for less than needed. There simply was no proposal the township trustees could agree to, so the best solution is to form a township fire district.

A fire district will allow the Board to set the boundaries of that district and to consist only of unincorporated areas of the Township. Mr. Tiffany said this will take effect early 2017. He said it is technically active today, but not funded until 2017. Mr. Tiffany said we are currently collecting levy money generated in 2014 since

collections are a year behind. He said in 2016 a levy on the ballot will collect money for payment in 2017. He said we will remove the 5 current levies taxed at 7.8 mills and replace it with one levy at 5.3 mills. He also said four of the current levies are indefinite and one was passed for 5 years. Mr. Tiffany said the new levy would be for five years and will result in a slight decrease in taxes. He said once the Fire District is established, any territory annexed would automatically be removed from the established unincorporated district. Mr. Tiffany said for those reasons the Board believes this is a good idea. He said this will be a seamless change since we will be providing the same service. Mrs. Daugherty thanked Mr. Tiffany for the explanation. Mr. Bryant said we created this a year ago and pulled it because of additional negotiations with Centerville. He said there can be only one T.I.F. at a time and unfortunately for Centerville they cannot institute theirs until ours is finished. Because we would not give up our T.I.F., negotiations came to a halt. Mr. Bryant said the Fire District will help secure our borders. It is not something we enjoy doing, but it is in the best interest of the Township. Mr. Pittman said this has precedence in Ohio. Mr. Pittman said, an expert in this area also provided us with legal opinion. Mr. Pittman said the Greene County Prosecutors office will represent us in this matter and there will be no expense to the Township. Mr. Pittman said Stephanie Haden, Greene County Prosecutors Office has already spent a lot of hours on this.

C. New Fire District Levy Outside the 10 Mil Limitation.

Resolution No. 2015.10.19.07

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Sugarcreek Township, Greene County, Ohio, (the "Board") previously formed and established the Sugarcreek Township Fire District consisting of the unincorporated areas of Sugarcreek Township, Greene County, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is the taxing authority for the Sugarcreek Fire District; and,

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the 10 mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Sugarcreek Township Fire District and its Fire Department and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the purposes contained in Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19(I); and,

WHEREAS, prior to making a determination of the necessity for a levy, the Township is required to certify a request to the County Auditor for certain information.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Trustee Bryant, seconded by Trustee Daugherty, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SUGARCREEK TOWNSHIP GREENE COUNTY, OHIO, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE AND IT HEREBY IS ADOPTED:

1. This Board declares that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Sugarcreek Fire District, pursuant to Section 5705.19(I) of the Ohio Revised Code, for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefore, or sources of water supply and materials therefore, or the establishment and maintenance of lines

of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company.

2. The Greene County Auditor is hereby requested to certify to the Sugarcreek Township Board of Trustees the total current tax valuation of Sugarcreek Township (unincorporated areas only) and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the following additional Fire District tax levy:
 - a) 5.3 mill
3. The above referenced proposed levy would be new and additional tax for a five (5) year period and would be placed upon the primary election ballot to be held on March 16, 2016 for the purposes contained in Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(I). The proposed levy would be placed upon the tax list and duplicate of 2016 for collection in 2017, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.
4. The Township Fiscal Office is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this resolution request to the Greene County Auditor and if necessary, the Greene County Board of Elections.
5. It is hereby declared that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time provided by law.

Mr. Bryant moved to accept the Resolution as presented. Mrs. Daugherty seconded. Roll was called with the vote being as follows:

D. Intent to Terminate Fire Levies Following Passage of Fire District Levy

Resolution No. 2015.10.19.08

WHEREAS, the voters of Sugarcreek Township have approved Sugarcreek Fire Protection (Fire Department) continuing levies of .30 mill in 1982, 2.90 mill in 1996, 1.30 mill in 2005, 1.30 mill in 2009 and a five (5) year levy of 2.00 mill in 2013, with all levies totaling 7.80 mill.

WHEREAS, in order to phase out the Township's current Fire Department, the Board of Trustees ("the Board") of Sugarcreek Township, Greene County, Ohio, on October 19, 2015, passed a resolution requesting the Board of Elections to place, on a Township-wide basis for the unincorporated acres, a 5.3 mill levy for the operation of the Sugarcreek Township Fire District on the March 16, 2016 primary ballot; and,

WHEREAS, the Board, by placing a 5.30 mill Fire levy on the ballot, is asking the residents of the Township to approve changing the taxing bodies from the "department" to the Township Fire District; and,

WHEREAS, the approval of the 5.30 mill Fire levy on the March 16, 2016 primary ballot is intended, in effect, to replace the current Fire Department levies (originally totaling 7.80 mills) and will not increase taxes for those Township residents currently subject to the Fire Department levies; and,

WHEREAS, if the residents of Sugarcreek Township approve the 5.30 mill Fire levy on March 16, 2016 primary ballot, the Board believes it is in the best interest of the Township and its residents to terminate the existing Fire Department levies totaling 7.80 mills.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Trustee Pittman, seconded by Trustee Daugherty, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SUGARCREEK TOWNSHIP, GREENE COUNTY, OHIO, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE AND IT HEREBY IS ADOPTED:

Section 1. Contingent upon the approval by the voters of Sugarcreek Township of a 5.30 mill Township-wide Fire District levy on the March 16, 2016 primary ballot, the Board of Trustees will terminate the five existing Fire District levies, of .30 mill approved in 1982, 2.90 mill approved in 1996, 1.30 mill approved in 2005, 1.30 mill approved in 2009 and a five (5) year levy of 2.00 mill approved in 2013.

Section 2. It is hereby declared that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the 19th day of October, 2015.

Mr. Pittman moved to accept the Resolution as presented. Mr. Bryant seconded. Roll was called with the vote as follows:

11. Public Comments:

Barbara Burson said some of the pages of the Resolutions were missing, stating it was hard to follow. Mr. Pittman apologized and said we have a new Administrative Assistant. Cara went to make copies for Barbara Burson.

Jim Martin asked who will run the Fire District. Mr. Tiffany said the Trustees. He asked what the Township has been talking about with Bellbrook and Mr. Tiffany said it has been about sharing service and equipment. Mr. Martin said then we won't be buying the same equipment. Mr. Martin was supportive of the new Fire District based on what was said tonight.

Donna Hellman said she wanted to make sure she understood that if another annexation occurred in the new Fire District, the annexed property would no longer be in the Fire District. Mr. Tiffany said that was correct. Mr. Tiffany mentioned a case involving the City of Dublin near Columbus, regarding Fire service and they used a Fire District to protect themselves. Mr. Tiffany said it will reduce the threat in our township of future Type II annexations. Mr. Tiffany stated there will be some public forum meetings sometime in January and he would let the Dayton Daily News know of the schedule.

Mr. Rick Parsons, of Parsons Hook Rd Body Shop spoke regarding the Township's towing rotation which he feels is being unfairly administered. Mr. Parsons provided a packet of information to the Board that he prepared, which addressed previously discussed issues such as pricing, towing lots, response times and crash site cleanup. He said he wanted to know, in view of the information he had presented, why Sandy's gets the majority of the tow calls instead of a more even rotation. Mrs. Daugherty thanked Mr. Parsons for the packet and told him it looked like he spent a lot of time on his presentation. She said she will look it over and give it consideration. Mr. Pittman said he appreciated the presentation and said he would look into it also. Mr. Bryant said we turned our dispatch over to Greene County and sent them a list for towing rotation. He said we can only ask dispatch to do a rotation, but this is something we don't know how to enforce. Mr. Parson said he didn't think the problem was with dispatch. He said he thinks the problem is with the Police Sergeants requesting Sandy's service. Mrs. Daugherty said she would like to read through everything and discuss it in work session.

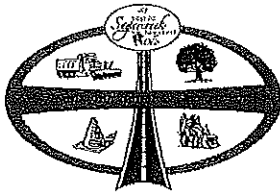
