IN RE: Authorizing the Chairperson to Sign a Memorandum of Understanding with the Greene
Soil and Water Conservation District

WHEREAS, the uninterrupted operations of the Township are necessary for the preservation of health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees have reviewed the Memorandum of Understanding regarding the responsibilities of the Greene Soil and Water Conservation District as well as Sugarcreek Township's responsibilities in providing assistance to the citizens of Sugarcreek Township, Greene County, Ohio regarding water quality problems related to non-point source of pollution (hereto attached); and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees recognize this as an important endeavor designed to assist in the safety of Township citizens and visitors,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby authorize the Chairperson to sign the Memorandum of Understanding with the Greene Soil and Water Conservation District regarding water quality problems related to non-point source of pollution including (but not limited to) erosion control, drainage practices and storm water control.

Memorandum of Understanding
Between the
Greene Soil and Water Conservation District
And
Sugar creek Township

This agreement is to identify the responsibilities of the Greene Soil and Water Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as "District") and Sugar creek Township (hereinafter referred to as "Township") in providing assistance to the citizens of Sugar creek Township, Greene County, Ohio regarding water quality problems related to non-point source of pollution including (but not limited to) Erosion Control, Drainage practices and Stormwater Control.

It is Mutually agreed that:


The District will:

- 1) Provide the Township with information regarding existing drainage systems, including surface and subsurface drainage, and stormwater control structures which may be on file in the District Office.
- 2) Inform all cooperative drainage groups of the drainage maintenance laws and encourage them to petition for maintenance.
- 3) Consult with the Township regarding highway, plat, lot splits, single residence, construction and / or maintenance projects with potential erosion, drainage and / or stormwater problems affecting the right-of-way or property.
- 4) Assist the Township with interpretations of soils information based on the published "Soil Survey for Greene County".
- 5) Provide on-site consultative assistance to the Township regarding Erosion, Drainage and Stormwater control practices specific in construction plans approved by Greene County Regional Planning and Coordinating Commission.
- 6) Verify Erosion and Stormwater Control measures are being followed per the construction drawings, plat maps and on-site inspections. Consult with Contractors, Developer, Landowners, Greene County Engineering Staff, Greene County Regional Planning and Coordinating Commission Staff, Environmental Protection Agency or others responsible to make certain that work is being performed to conform with the Runoff Control Sediment- Abatement Resolution of Greene County, Ohio and any resolutions or ordinances adopted by the Township. Assistance will be provided from planning to completion of the project.
- 7) Maintain summaries and upon completion, sum up results to show project Compliance or Non-Compliance. Make certain that Erosion and Stormwater controls are specifically identified and correctly installed and maintained during construction.


The Township will:

- 1) Refer Erosion Control, Stormwater Control and Drainage Projects to the District.
- 2) Cooperate with the District in implementing Erosion Control, Stormwater Control and Drainage practices in areas within its jurisdiction.
- 3) Support District programs designed to improve water quality in Sugarcreek Township in rural and urban areas by addressing non-point source pollution problems.
- 4) Reimburse the District for technical services listed above in the amount of \$0.00 per hour according to terms specified in this Memo of Understanding (MOU) between the two parties. At the end of a two year period this monetary remuneration will be reviewed as the actual expenses and will be re-negotiated at that time.
- 5) Participate in informational meetings with other units of Government and the general public, dealing with items of mutual interest to the District, the Township and the Regional Planning and Coordinating Commission.
- 6) Will submit any applications for new commercial and residential principal structure zoning permits to the District for review and recommendations relating to Erosion, Stormwater and Drainage. The Township will forward all recommendations to the applicant.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is subject to revision or cancellation by written notice from either party at any time.




