RESOLUTION NO. 2017.01.09.02

IN RE: Declaring Fire Department Property Excess/Obsolete and Directing the Township Administrator to Post for Public Auction and/or Contract for Sale.

WHEREAS, a well equipped fleet of vehicles is necessary for the preservation of life and property in Sugarcreek Township; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Jeffrey Leaming and the Fire Department staff concur that ladder truck Quint 72 is obsolete and not the proper type of apparatus to best serve Sugarcreek Township; and


WHEREAS, Quint 72, a 2013 KME Aerialcat platform ladder truck was acquired through a FEMA grant in 2014; and,

WHEREAS, Chief Leaming through his communications with Mr. Kevin Piatt at FEMA, has received permission from FEMA to sell the ladder truck with the understanding that the proceeds will be used to purchase a better suited vehicle for our community needs; and,

WHEREAS, R.C. 505.10 governs the Township's ability and process to dispose of property in excess of \$2,500 in value, requiring that the item be placed at public auction or by sealed bid for a minimum of fourteen (14) days and sold to the highest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Trustees of Sugarcreek Township, Ohio, does hereby declare Quint 72 to be excess/obsolete and directs the Township Administrator to list the truck for sale at auction for 14 days with a reserve price of \$650,000 in accordance with R.C. 505.10(A).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the truck not reach the reserve price or more and sell at auction, the Township Administrator is directed to contract with a dealer or broker for the sale of the truck at a price of no less than \$650,000 in accordance with R.C. 505.10(B).
