
IN RE: Resignation of Volunteer Firefighter, Garrett S. Blakley

WHEREAS, Firefighter Garrett S. Blakley has submitted his letter of resignation from the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department; and,


WHEREAS, Firefighter Blakley has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since February 1, 2010; and,
