WHEREAS, this Board would like to take advantage of available state funding intended to incentivize this type of innovation; and


WHEREAS, this Board feels this initiative is of paramount importance and is to be pursued on a priority basis with whatever resources are needed; and



FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, all Township personnel are directed to assist freely in this effort when called upon to do so.


FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, the Administrator is to report weekly the progress of this effort expected to be concluded within three months with recommendations to the Board of Trustees.
