


WHEREAS, the Township Trustees previously authorized the Township Administrator to enter into the agreement on their behalf for the study of improvements in the I-675/Wilmington Pike Corridor; and,


WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Transportation Improvement District, The Board of Commissioners of Greene County, the City of Centerville and Sugar Creek Township have determined it in the best interest of the communities and region to expand the scope of the study area and criteria to ensure there is a comprehensive, concerted plan for the future regarding roadway improvements in the corridor and surrounding area; and,


WHEREAS, Sugar Creek Township, the City of Centerville and Greene County have agreed to share equally in the estimated cost of \$615,000 for the study and report, to be funded through local funds and a loan from the State of Ohio's State Infrastructure Bank; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Barry Tiffany, Township Administrator, is hereby authorized to act as signatory for the Modified Management and Financing Agreement for the I-675/Wilmington Pike Interchange Projects and any other documents necessary for the completion of the project and submission to the State of Ohio State Infrastructure Bank for funding of the project.
