

**SUGARCREEK TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF ZONING COMMISSION
TUESDAY, March 9, 2021**

This regular meeting of the Sugar creek Township Board of Zoning Commission was held on Tuesday, March 9, 2021 via Zoom at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Betz called the meeting to order.
