IN RE: Resignation of Part-time Firefighter/Paramedic, Megan A. Carboni


WHEREAS, Firefighter Megan A. Carboni has submitted her letter of resignation from the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department; and,

WHEREAS, Firefighter Carboni has been a member of the Sugarcreek Township Fire Department since December 2, 2002; and,



Dear Chief Pavlak;


