IN RE: Authorizing the Fire Chief to Enter Into an Agreement with Robert Saul Construction


WHEREAS, the uninterrupted operations of Sugarcreek Township are necessary for the preservation of health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, Chief Randall J. Pavlak and Chief Gilbert A. Flick have proposed renovations to Station 72, which will benefit both police and fire personnel, for the purpose of combining two (2) offices into one (1) large work area placing a doorway for the new work area into the Fire Chief's office as well as moving the existing Fire Department hallway door to accommodate an interview/medical room for walk-in patients and police interviews; and,



WHEREAS, Chief Randall J. Pavlak states the renovations are not to exceed Nine-Thousand Five-Hundred Dollars (\$9,500),


